A coil bound or sewn sketchbook, 90#, and suitable for watercolor. Examples: Strathmore 400 series (many people like this one, decent paper, and black cover), Canson XL Mixed Media sketchbook, Handbook, Moleskine. At least 5x8" is a good size.

Waterproof black pen

Examples: Uni-Ball vision elite (light grey with black fisheye top, says waterproof); Faber-Castell Pitt, medium or fine; Pigma Micron .05

Paints - Please read this carefully!

A small travel paintbox that hinges shut

I want you to use professional quality watercolors, as the cheap paints are bad color choices and unsatisfying. If you do not have any good paints, there are two options I offer.

- ★ I can make a small travel paintbox for you with ten professional colors for \$65. Please order from me at least one week before class.
- ★ You can rent a paintbox from me for \$5 for the day.

• Watercolor brush, round, size #8 or #10

There are many options. I suggest a Princeton (Heritage model 4050-R) will be adequate.

- Water containers: 3 small yogurt size
- Rag/terrycloth
- Soft pencil

Graphite pencil #4B or a regular 2B

Kneaded eraser
